

# European Nuclear Society Young Generation Network (ENS YGN) Grant Program 2024

We invite individuals from ENS member countries to apply for a grant to support attendance at IYNC2024. Applicants are required to meet specific criteria and must be supported with evidence as required.

Conditions for grant application:

- Applicants must be at least 18 and maximum 35 (born before 31.12.1989)
- Applicants must not have a full participation funding from any other party
- The grant candidate should be a member of ENS member country national society.
- The applicant should have an accepted summary for a presentation or an accepted poster at IYNC
- The value of a grant is a maximum of 900€ (nine hundred Euros) for the cover of registration, transportation, or lodging expenses
- The grants are awarded for “in person” or “online” attendance

The closing date for applications will be the **30.06.2024 at 20:00 Central European Time**. Late submissions will not be considered. Successful applicants will be informed by email before 07.07.2024. Grant funding will be provided to successful applicants after IYNC2024 via BACS payment into their personal bank account provided following successful evidence of IYNC attendance (and provision of expenses justifications (bills, invoices)).

Applicants have to provide:

- Completed application form (below). The application form is to be sent as a **word** file (mandatory)
- Evidence of Age by scanned official identification document (mandatory)
- Evidence of membership of an ENS member society. The list of ENS member societies can be found at <https://www.euronuclear.org/about-us/member-societies/>
- Information about any other sources of funding already secured or applied for
- Evidence of an accepted abstract for an oral/poster presentation/workshop at IYNC 2024
- The accepted abstract
- Short CV (max. 1 page)
- A support letter from their YGN leadership representative (president, member of the board, ...)

If the application is successful, the applicant must provide proof of IYNC2024 attendance following the conference before any grant reimbursement payment can be made. To obtain the reimbursement, successful applicants have to provide:

- Evidence of paid registration to IYNC 2024
- Evidence of any expenses that the grant should cover
- Two to three paragraphs about the impressions from the attendance at the IYNC and a picture showing the grantee at the IYNC.

## Evaluating criteria

These grants support students and young professionals attending the IYNC 2024 in Abu Dhabi, UAE. Its aim is to bridge the financial barrier of the conference for talented young people studying, working, or doing research in the nuclear field.

The grants increase the diversity of the meeting and support the participation of YGN members from Europe. The maximum number of awards for each country is restricted. All the received applications will be studied, but the number of grants is limited.

According to the conditions of the grants distribution, priority will be given to:

- Applicants that are members of an ENS member society.
- Applicants having an accepted abstract for presentation or poster or is actively involved in organisation of the congress
- Applicants who have not been awarded ENS-YGN grants previously
- Undergraduate students, and master or Ph.D. students
- Applicants without further funding. Any funding sources should be disclosed.

In case of parity of score, priority will be given to the youngest applicants. In addition, attention will be paid to the quality of the work submitted to IYNC2024, the competencies and capacities highlighted in the CV, and the support letter of YGN.
